3.1 Links with national accounts

NA preliminary data are the basic data source for the social protection benefits in ESSPROS early estimation, especially for benefits in kind. There are some accounting or conceptual differences, for instance: Allocation of certain items by ESSPROS functions differs from COFOG classification (for instance, consumer price subsidy on public passenger transport); Social housing benefit of the local governments is derived from extra estimation based on dwelling statistic data; The benefits provided by private pension/health insurance funds S.12 are excluded from ESSPROS. Some items of COFOG 10.7 from NA D.631 estimation are distributed to 2,3,5 ESSPROS functions not to 8 function; The data source for unemployment function is different, but the concept is the same, mainly the passive measures/expenditures of labour market policy are covered by both account systems as social protection benefit; The NACE classification is not fully appropriate to classify NA D.631 86-88 aggregates (benefits in kind) of S.15 NPISH to ESSPROS functions, so additional data source is used for the division by function: operation benefit expenditures of central government to non-governmental social protection providers, that are mainly non-profit institutions; Social welfare benefits provided by employers to their employees are excluded from ESSPROS;
