






Europeana mobile use and users

This graphic identifies the mobile platforms and countries that make the most intensive use of Europeana. The blobs are scaled to the number of individual users and the colours represent the iPad (in red), iPhone (in blue) and Blackberry (in yellow).


The message is very clear: the iPad tablet provides a user experience that encourages longer, deeper sessions in Europeana and this represents a step change in behaviour compared, for example, with Android users.


French iPad users have pulled away from the pack as the largest group and the most intensive consumers of Europeana on the go.

Baroque Music

Baroque music - like all music - divides opinions strongly: some people enjoy its rich texture and abundant decorations while others might feel that all Baroque music sounds the same with popular chord progressions being used over and over again. The era of Baroque music often means the period from the beginning of the 17th century to 1750, the year Johann Sebastian Bach died. Famous composers from the Baroque era also include, among others, Johann Pachelbel, Henry Purcell, Antonio Vivaldi, Georg Philipp Telemann and Domenico Scarlatti. The Baroque era in music started over 400 years ago but many pieces from that era are still being played. Here's a couple of examples of typical Baroque music!



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



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An act of courage and a gift of friendship



L.A.C. Bernard Darley (Service no. 28345), R.A.F., was commended for fighting a fire at Workshop No. 2 M.T.R.D. Royal Air Force, St Omer. He entered a burning building and fought the fire from within to prevent the explosion of two petrol filled tanks and the possibility of an electrical fire spreading to a nearby power station, at great risk to his own life.

He was assisted through the entire operation by a German Prisoner of War named Otto Arndt of the 139th P.O.W. Company. The two became friends. Otto crafted Bernard a matchbox (pictured here) as a gift and a reminder of their joint act of courage. Images of the matchbox and papers detailing Bernard's gallantry were submitted to The Great War Archive by Bernard's great-granddaughter, Merilyn Jones of Sutton

Coldfield.
