






The CAP post 2020 – political agreement

- **25 June 2021** negotiators of the European Parliament, the Council of the EU and the European Commission, agreed on the reform of the CAP
- This provisional political agreement paves the way for the formal approval of the necessary legislation by the European Parliament and the Council in the autumn of 2021






The CAP post 2020 – in force on 1/1/2023

- The CAP Strategic Plan regulation provides many new or improved tools for AKIS under the Cross-Cutting Objective:
 - Farm advice: MS must have all impartial advisors integrated within the AKIS able to cover all 3 sustainability fields with up-to-date K&I => well « qualified » advisors
 - Obligatory training for advisors
 - Support for **knowledge exchange** and information events, including for advice, demo and training, thematic and cross-sectorial events, support for networks
 - Obligation to provide innovation support (« hub ») for OGs => helping bottom-up individual grassroots ideas to be developed into an OG project proposal
 - CAP networks: connect existing OGs & interact with Horizon Europe NCPs (seminar June 2021 on EIP website)
 - EIP Operational Groups: 80% EU cofinancing instead of 43%. Interactive innovation principles mandatory.
 Advance payments up to 50%. State Aid derogation till 350.000 Euro project (published July 2021).
- CAP Strategic Plans to be submitted formally to the Commission by 1/1/2022



Horizon Europe Mission Work-Programme 2021/2022

Topic HORIZON-MISS-2021-SOIL-01-01: "Preparing the ground for healthy soils - building capacities for engagement, outreach and knowledge"

Action to identify regional "soil needs" and monitoring requirements, map existing living labs and lighthouses and help to create a one-stop shop for soil information.

Deadline: 20 October 2021

- Updated Horizon Europe Mission Work Programme 2021/2022 (planned):
- to be adopted and published end of December 2021
- deadline for submission of proposals: end of March 2022
- more substantial number of topics to initiate the mission
- currently under negotiation with Member States
