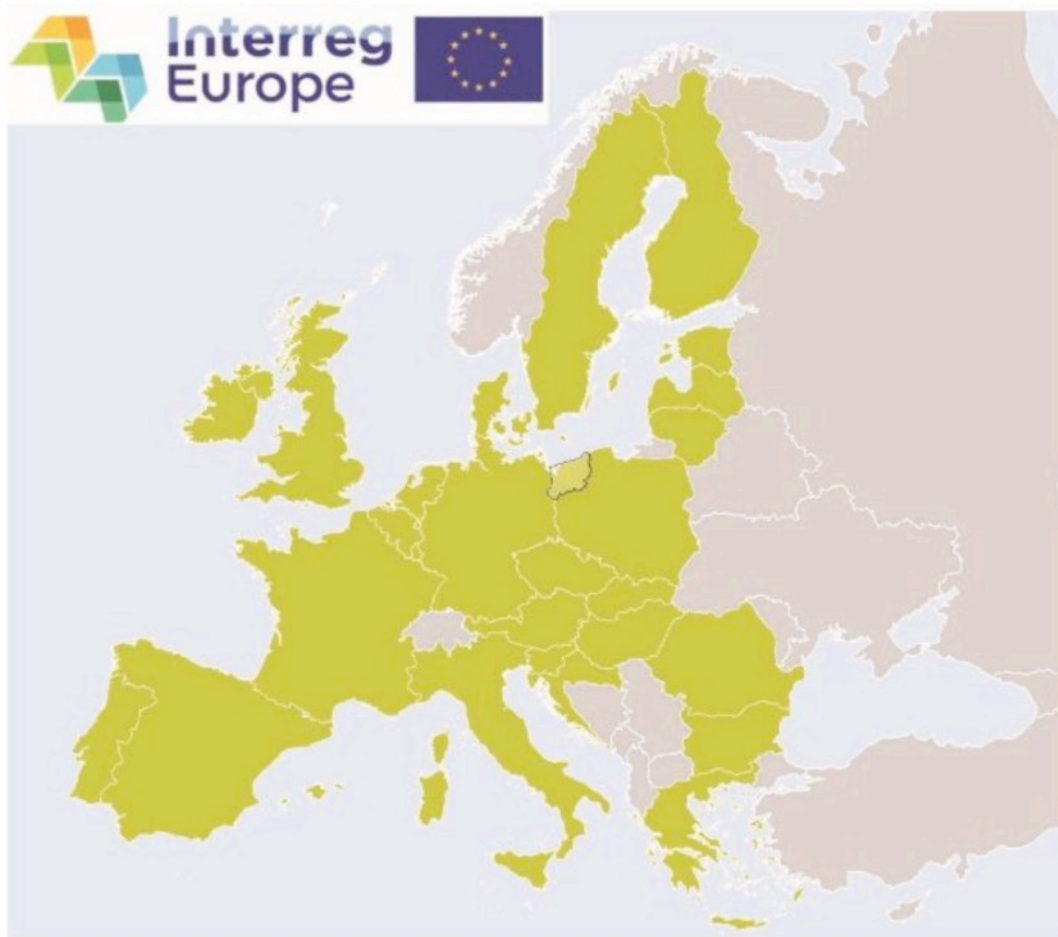

Mechanism of support for marginalized areas in West Pomerania



Pomorze Zachodnie (West Pomerania)



1 682 003 inhabitants (1 722 739 - 2011)

68.6 % urbanization rate

Low population density - 74 people / km²

Almost 90% of the voivodeship's area are rural areas

Elderly population – 22,7%

Mechanism of support in West Pomerania Local Government Contracts (LGC)

What the LGC is?

Agreement between Voivodeship Self-Government and unions / associations of local government for implementation of the local strategies.

Each of unions of local government had to prepare joint strategy / diagnosis of the area based on common potential.

The strategies had to include a package of projects contributing to the solution of problems or the enhancement of potentials.



Mechanism of support in West Pomerania Local Government Contracts (LGC)

Cooperation between local governments in order to solve common problems, was focus in the area of **local transport, labor market**, including support to investment areas – business parks, and **education**.

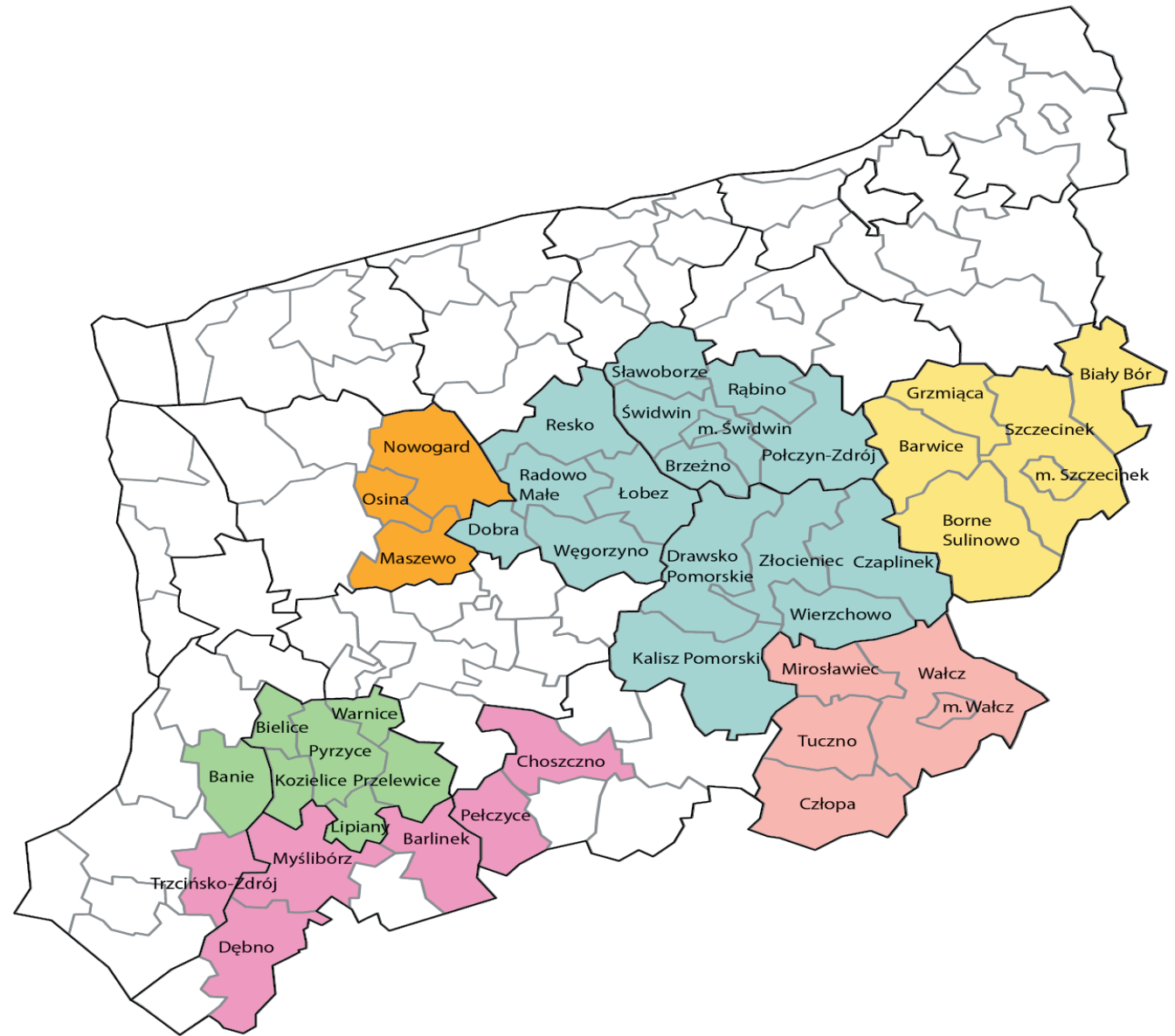


Local Government Contracts (L

6 LGCs for the implementation of 96 strategic projects with a total value of UE contribution 30,153 million EUR:

Available budget (ROP): 51.75 million euro (ERDF – 31.25 million EUR, ESF 20.5 million euro)

The scope of supported investments: enhancing the competitiveness of SMEs, promoting sustainable multimodal urban mobility, supporting labour mobility, investing in education, training and vocational training for skills and lifelong learning



Lessons learned

- Long term planning and territorial co-operation is crucial.
- Involvement of people (NGO's, local action groups, local leaders)
- Complementarity and optimization of public services
- Affordable public transport and better connectivity
