Abstract The presentation gives an overview of the United Nations International Civil Service Commission

(ICSC)'s Post Adjustment index, used to equalise the purchasing power of salaries around the world, relative to New York. It highlights how methodological and operational choices regarding the index formula, weighting schemes and aggregation procedures, as well as key features of the survey process, are informed by the search for the optimal balance between standard statistical principles and compensation policy goals. It also highlights important issues emanating from the ongoing review of the statistical methodology underpinning the PAI, which have the potential of introducing consequential

changes in the UN-ICSC's calculations.
