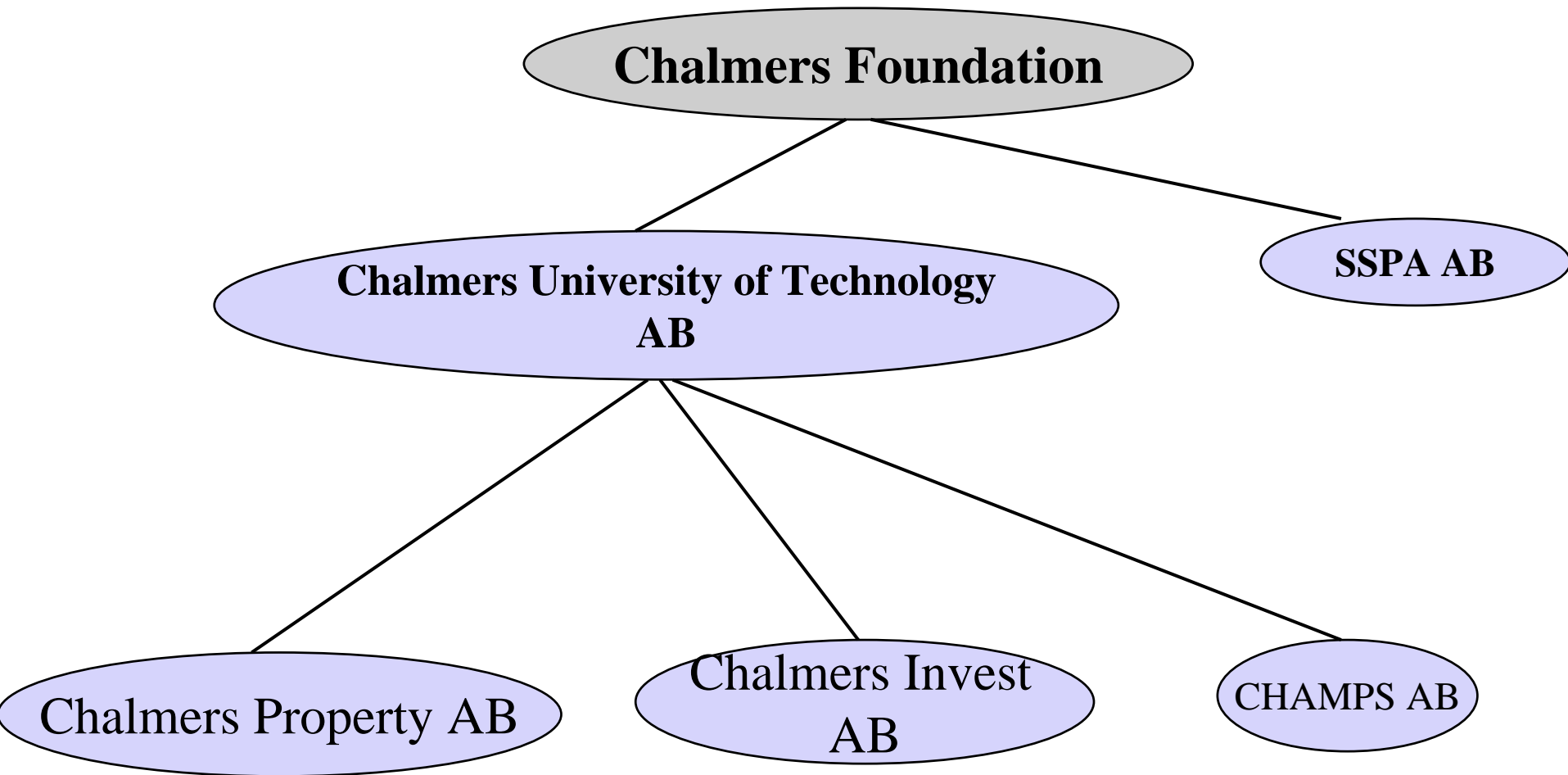

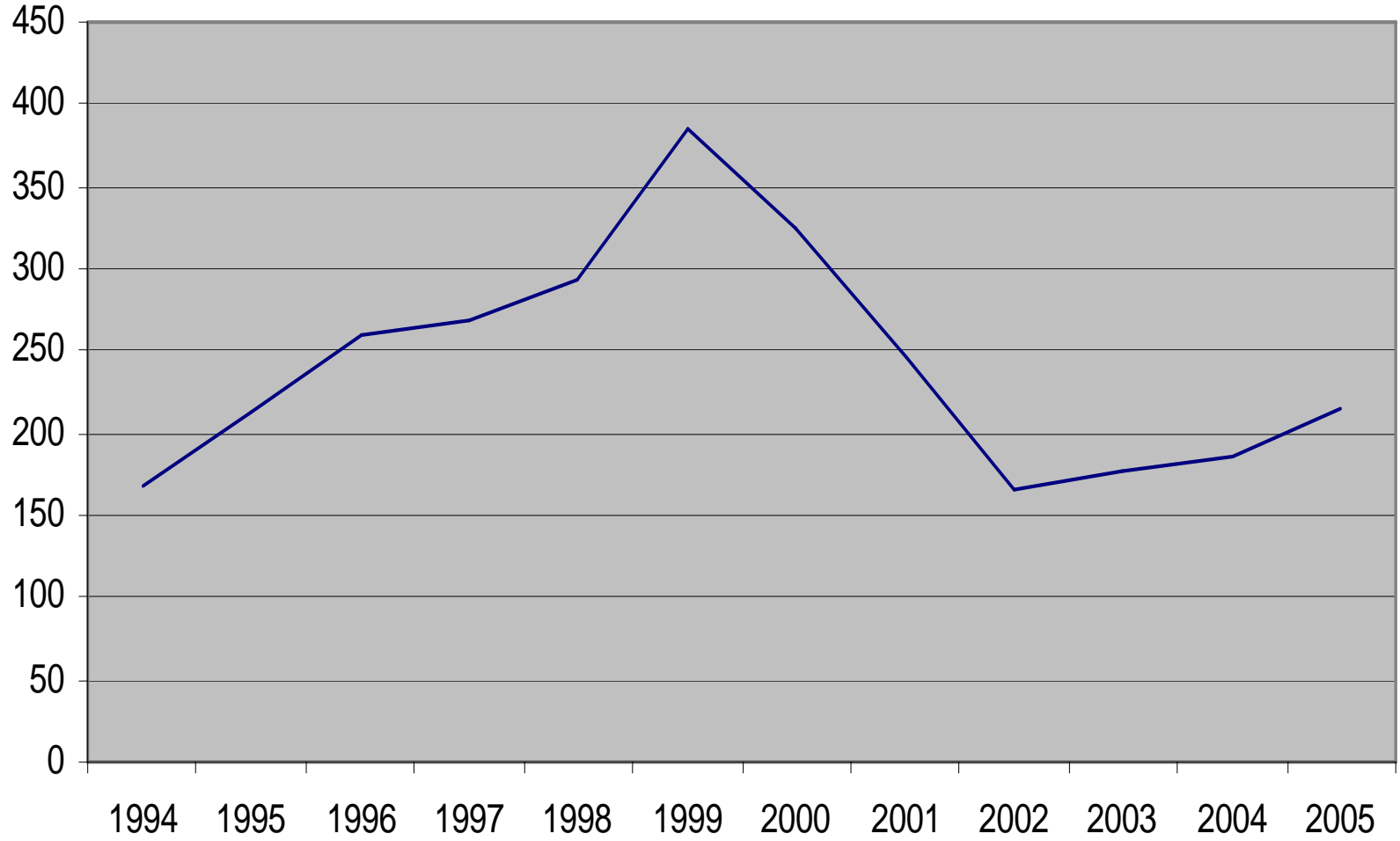

1 § The purpose of the Chalmers University of Technology Foundation is to

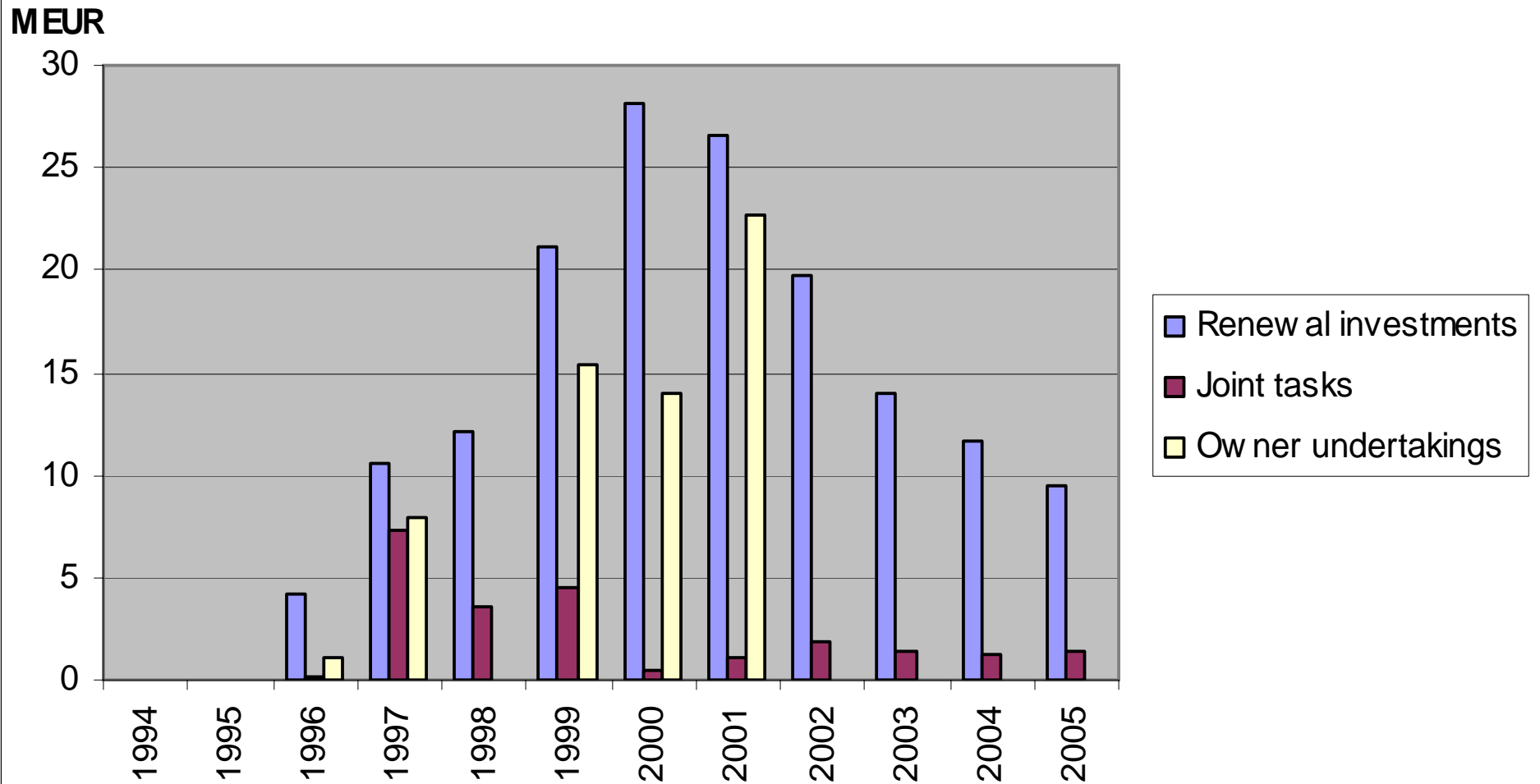

- d) appoint the board of directors of Chalmers Technical University AB

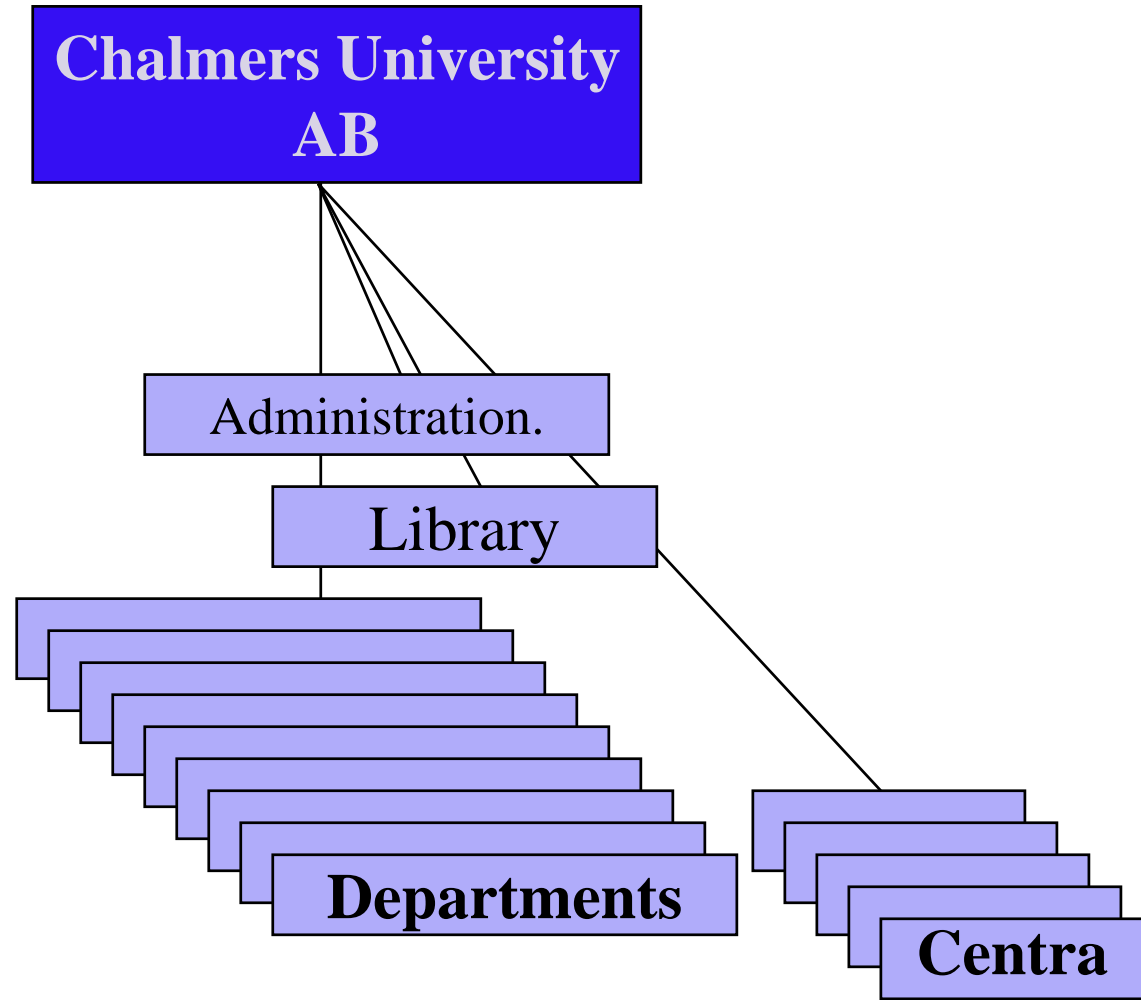
