- supervised by CREST
- multi-lateral
- issues of common interest
- decision by CREST
- limited support
- only countries
- no third countries

OMC-NET

- call for proposals
- smaller groups
- issues of specific interest
- bottom-up
- additional resources for support
- possibility to include regional actors
- third country participation possible



OMC-NET and FP7

- FP7 Specific Programme 'Capacities'
- Activity: 'Support for the Coherent Development of Research Policies'
- Support for bottom-up policy coordination activities undertaken by several countries/regions on issues of their specific interest
- 3 calls planned under FP7



Pilot call

- launched in 2005 under FP6
- budget : 8.6 M€
- 10 projects selected
- projects started end 2006
- projects ongoing
- presentations later today

Lessons learned

project topics

- mix between generic and focussed topics
- mix between R&D related and innovation related topics
- extent of coverage requested not always clear

policy impact

- involvement of public authorities is crucial
- sufficient level of ambition from the outset
- active dissemination
- linked clearly to topic selection



Lessons learned

size and duration

- no formal limits were set
- typical values resulting from call and evaluation
- 2 year duration
- 800 000 1 000 000 M€ Community contribution

project governance

- project formally managed by consortium
- extensive use is made of advisory groups, associated partners,...
- alternative views, maximise policy impact



Lessons learned

activities

- information gathering inventory typical first step
- prior existing information not always considered
- need to build synergy with other fora
