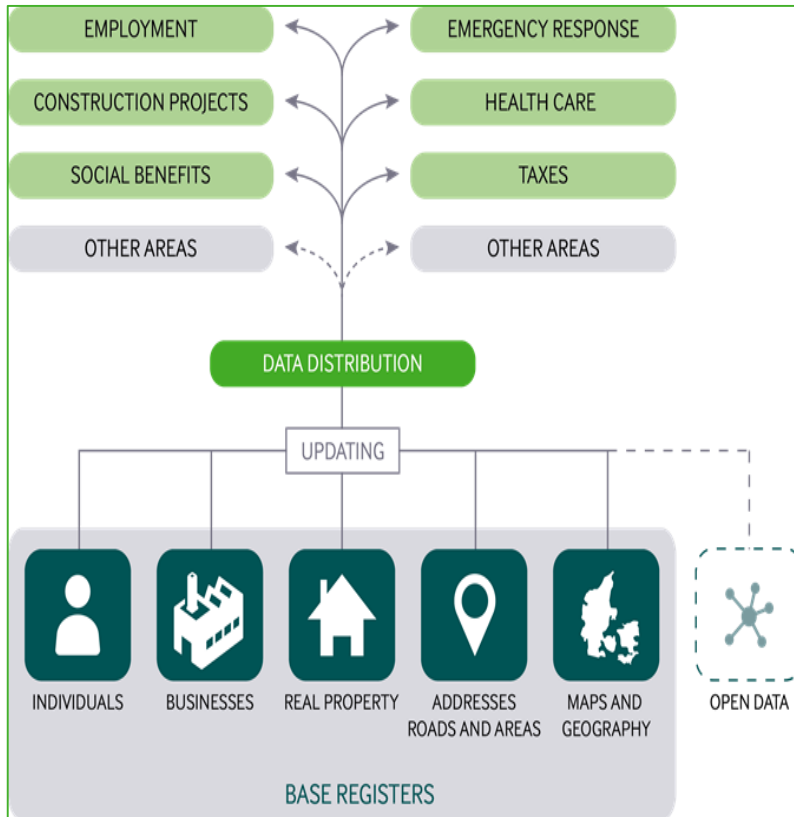

One-Stop-Shop for Open Data supporting digital End-to-End Services in the public and private sector

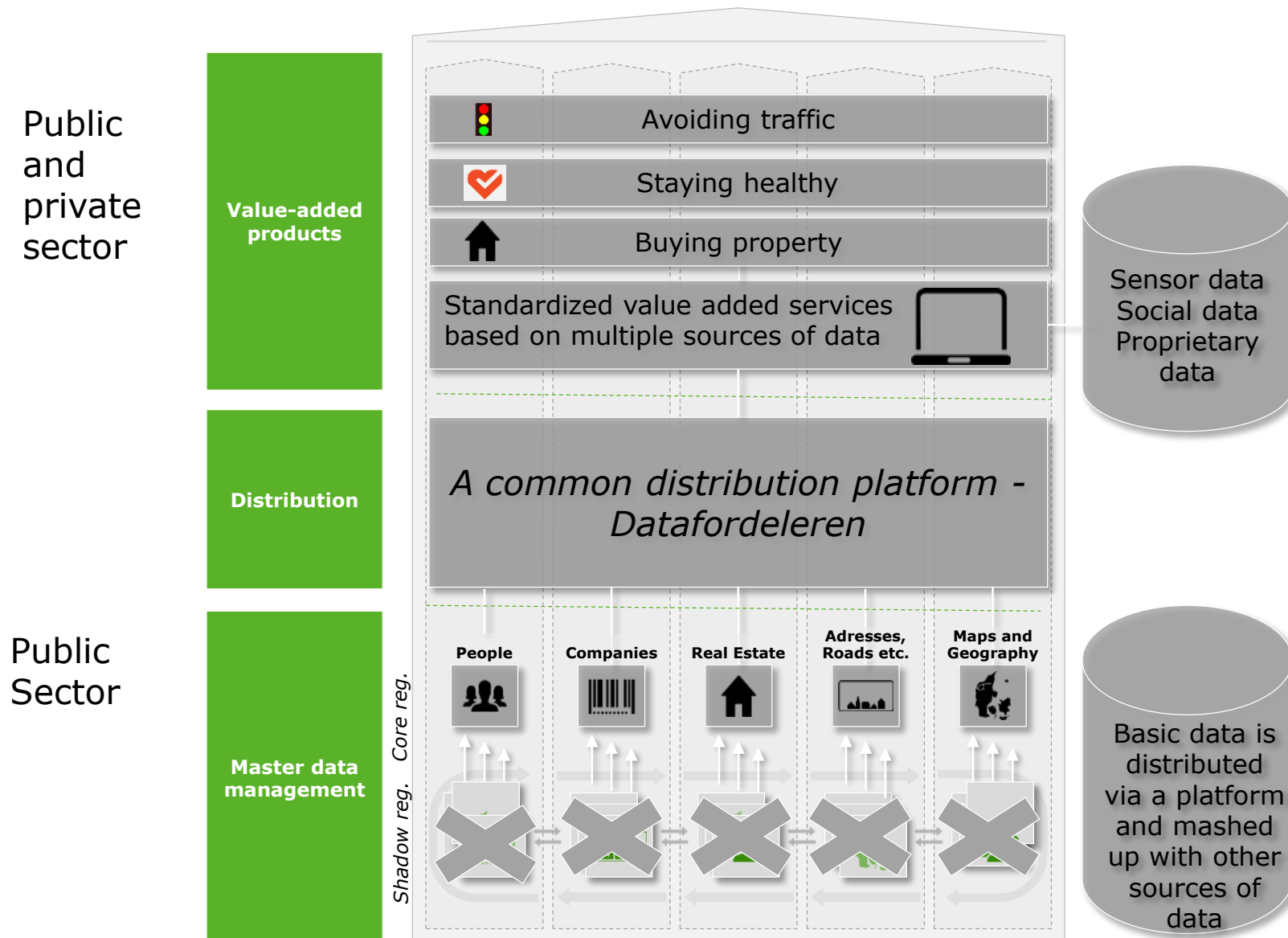
Fully developed and implemented **in mid-2017**. Reference implementation finalized October 2015.

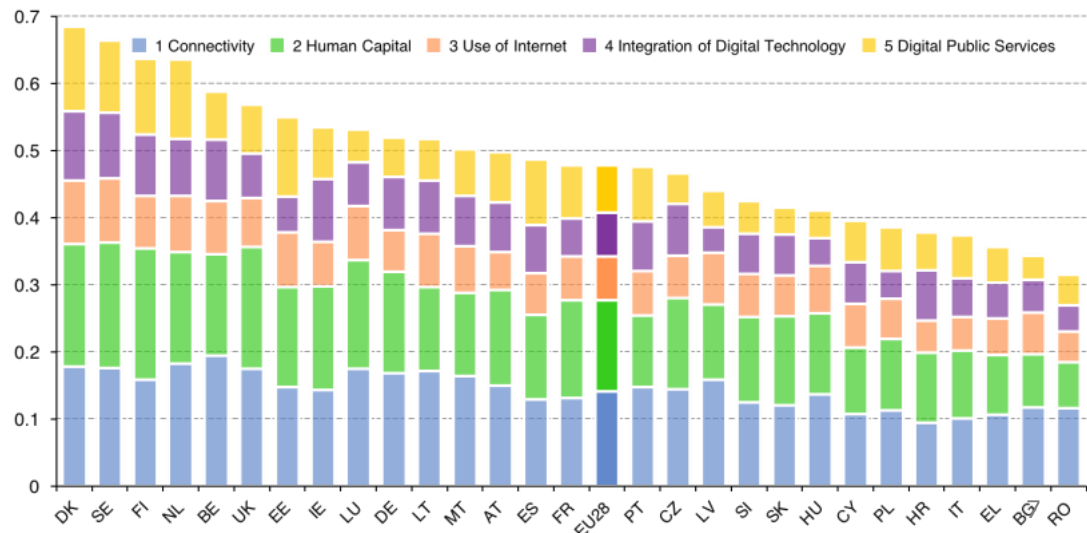
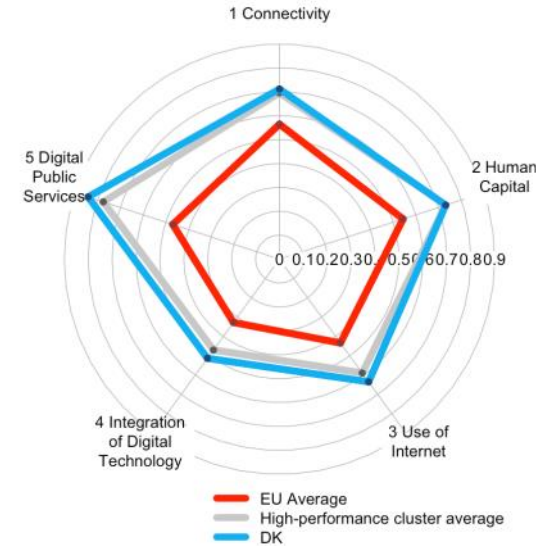


DENMARK IS A FRONTRUNNER ON EGOVERNMENT AND DIGITISATION OF THE PUBLIC SECTOR

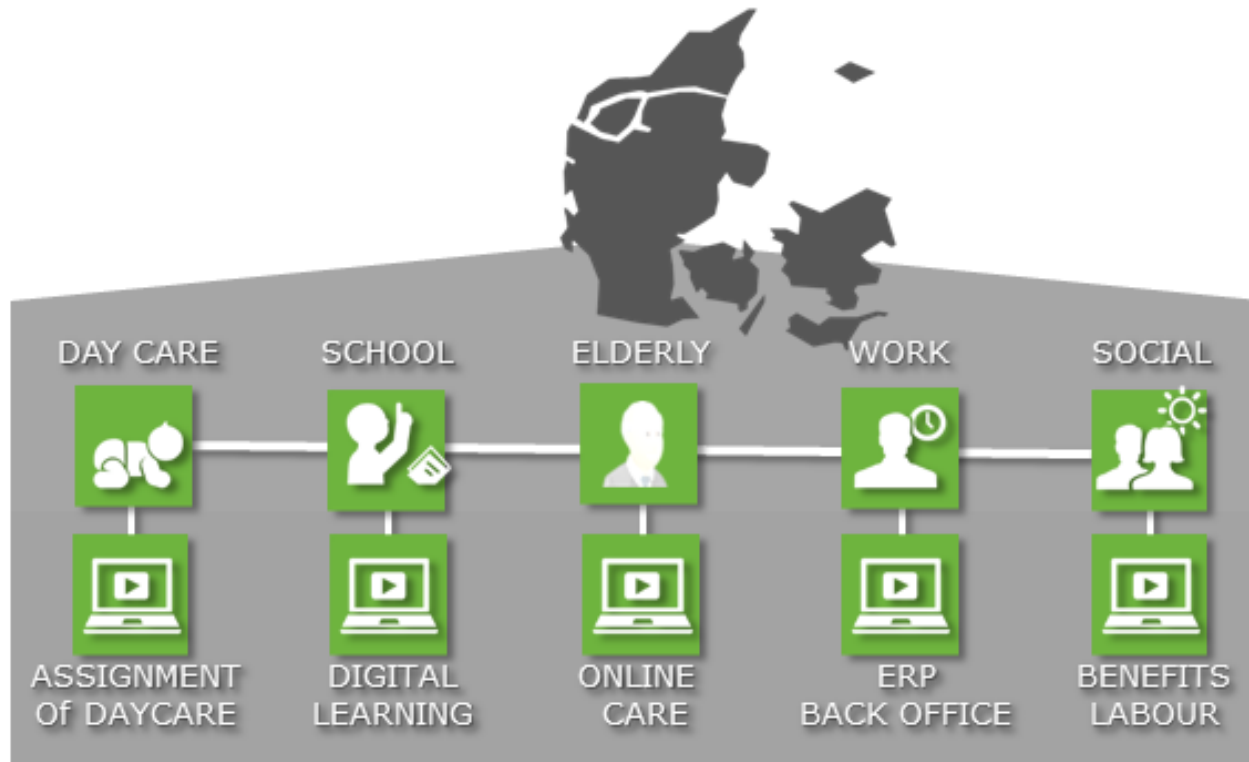
In DESI (The Digital Economy and Society Index) 2015, Denmark ranks 1st out of the 28 EU Member States and has the most advanced use of digital public services.

Denmark is gradually implementing a "digital by default" strategy for the most used citizen's public services, taking advantage of the high percentage of eGovernment users.

Denmark, Sweden, The Netherlands and Finland are the highest performing countries. They are not only ahead in the EU, but they are world leaders in digital.

KMD primarily develops administrative and enterprise management systems, and also develops solutions in citizen services, IT outsourcing, application management, BPO and a number of other areas.

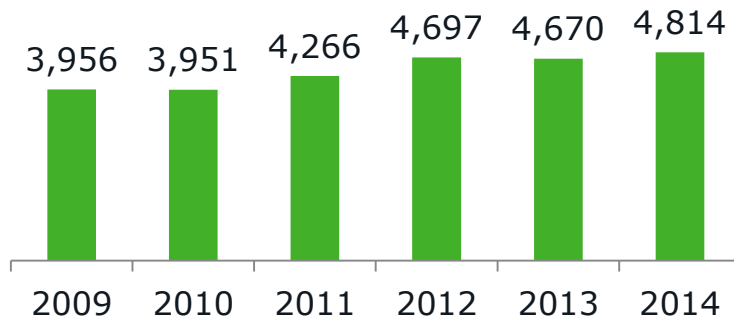
KMD has built and developed Danish IT infrastructure for over 40 years.

More than 400 billion DKK are processed by KMD's systems on an annual basis. This amounts to roughly 20% of the Danish GDP.

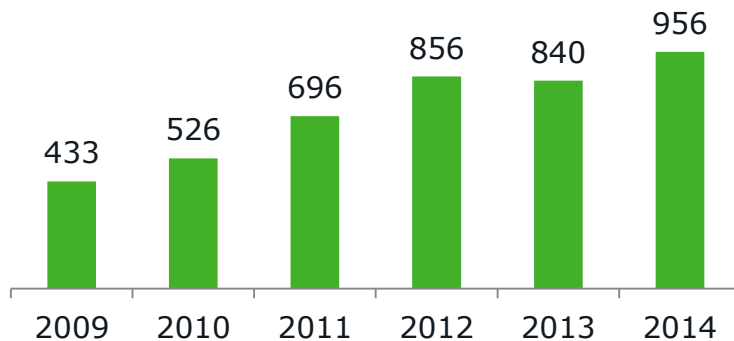



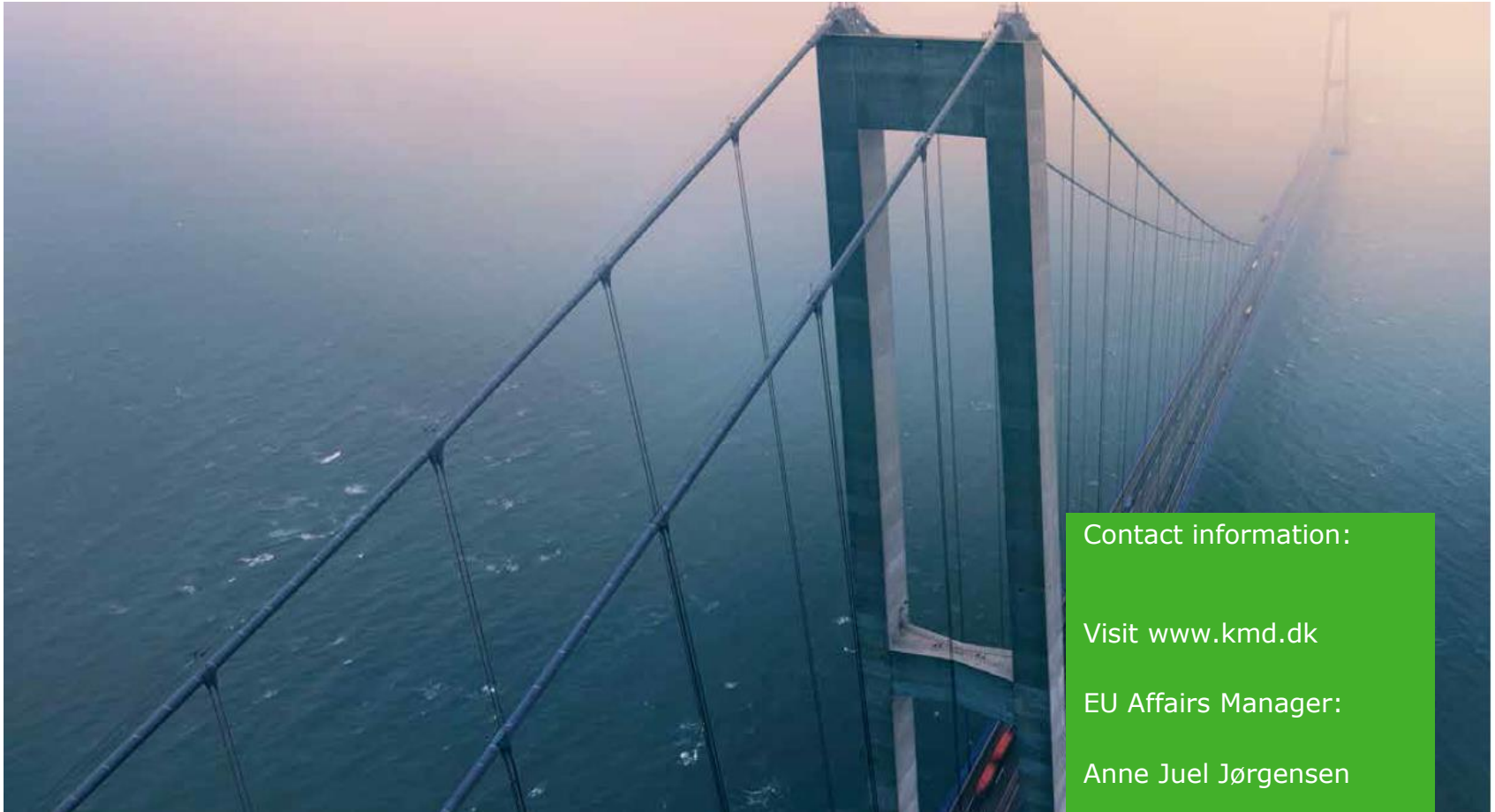
