The Spanish Geospatial common service: EGEO

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What is Egeo

Goal: Egeo allows the representation of maps with geo-referenced data; without the need for software development.

Scope: Egeo provides maps (thematic, geo-referenced and magnitude) on the basis of the information provided by the user entity and searcher of resources both on official geo-referenced maps of the IGN (National Geographic Institute), as well as of Google Maps.

The user entity embeds the maps in its website or application.

It also allows the generation of graphics (line, area, bar, column and sectors, and data tables).

Owner: Directorate for Information Technologies and Communications of the General State Administration

Target group: Entities of the Administration. Currently around 60 entities are carrying integration tests (including AEAT, GISS, MSSI, IGAE, INE, etc.)

Starting date: December 2014

What is the impact of EGEO

- EGEO facilitates the integration of geo spatial information in administrative processes.
- It provides cost savings because of the simplicity and the potential of the idea.
- Cloud service, based on open source, adapted to mobile devices.
