



How does the European Commission's Directorate for Informatics (DIGIT) contribute to your European Citizens' Initiative?

Free, open source Online Collection Software (OCS)

From April 2012 to April 2019, **45 out of 57** European Citizens' Initiatives have **used this software**. Three of the initiatives using the OCS collected more than 1 million signatures:

Water and sanitation are a human right! with 1 659 543 signatures

Free hosting service for the OCS software in the Commission data centre and **support for** the required **certification** of the system

Significant improvements in the procedure that have **reduced by half the time** needed to start the online collection for the initiatives hosted at the Commission data centre.

- **Simplification** of communication between the organisers and the Commission
- Implemented with the **latest technology** on Mobile development (Angular)
- **Upcoming release** (OCS 3.0) focusing on accessibility
