Context



Service Directive – aims at releasing the untapped growth potential of **services markets** in Europe by removing legal and administrative barriers to trade in the services sector.


The Directive requires that **all procedures** involved in establishing a business and providing services in another EU country to be **fully online**.

Point of Single Contact (PSC) - supporting the implementation of the directive and aims at overcoming administrative obstacles, streamlining procedures and offering seamless cross- border technology.

Challenges



- Several PSCs in 1 country;
- Different one-stop shops are not integrated;
- Different ways of describing and representing public services;
- Redundant descriptions of public services;
- Lack of user-centric approach for the PSCs;



Leading to:

- Lack of effectiveness and efficiency of PSCs;
- Higher costs for maintenance of information;
- Absence of an integrated view on life events, business events and public services provided within a specific country or region.

Goals of Action 1.3



- Develop a **standard specification** for uniformly describing key business events and related public services;
- Gather requirements and make available reusable software solutions;
- Blaborate on **best practices** for public service portfolio management;
- Support the Member States in adopting and using the standard specification, re-usable software and best practices

What is currently going on?



Documentation and **analysis** of BEs and PSs available on the PSCs of EU-28 and the Your Europe Portal

Collection of **good practices** and **guidelines** for
managing public service
portfolios

Building consensus on the Core Public Service Vocabulary Application Profile (CPSV-AP) Creation of functional and technical specifications for new reusable tools

Development of a handbook that will allow interested MSs to adopt and implement the CPSV-AP

Documentation of existing software tools that are being used in the 10 MSs for building and managing their PSCs





CPSV-AP: European reference data model:

- For describing business events and public services;
- Based on the <u>ISA Core Public Service Vocabulary</u>;

Which enables to:

- Provide high-quality descriptions of public services from a **user-centric** perspective by grouping them in key business events;
- Describe public services only once;
- **Standardise** descriptions of public services;
- Ease the integration of information available on competent authorities and other PSCs.

Reusable software tools implementing CPSV-AP



- CPSV-AP mapping tool, to map different data models used for describing your business events and public services to the CPSV-AP or any other data model.
- Public service description harvester, to get the public service descriptions in a faster and more efficient way and ease the creation of an integrated view on life events, BEs and PSs provided within a specific country or region.
- CPSV-AP data validator, to test the compliance of your data set with descriptions of business events and public services descriptions against the information requirements of the CPSV-AP.
- Public Service Description Editor, to describe your business events and public services following the CPSV-AP and export those descriptions in interoperable, machine-readable formats.
