1469 redundancies in the furniture sector. The application concerns personalised measure to be provided to the 636 workers still in need of assistance at the time of the application.

- outplacement assistance,

- promotion of entrepreneurship,

BACKGROUND

- Redundancies follow the steep slowdown in demand for furniture as a result of the economic crisis and the slowdown in construction activity.
- Lithuania has one of the highest rates of unemployment in the EU and alternative employment opportunities are few and far between.
- The economic crisis was unforeseen, and the Lithuanian furniture industry, which exported over 50% of its production was badly affected..
- The whole of Lithuania is affected, and the application concerns workers in the entire country. A total of 49 enterprises, mostly small and medium-sized enterprises, are cited in the application as having made workers redundant during the reference period.
